

Applying for the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit?

Here's what you'll need.

Taxpayers applying for the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit will need to supply the following information during the application process.

All applicants will need:
Taxpayer identification information for all Household members, including name , address , phone number , email , and Social Security Number
The federal Adjusted Gross Income from your 2022 tax return.
Student information, including name and Social Security Number
 This will be utilized to verify the student's Household federal Adjusted Gross Income, which then determines the amount of the tax credit.
An Enrollment Verification Form for each student
 The Enrollment Verification Form is provided by the registered accredited private school that the student attends or plans to attend. This is sent via email to the parent or guardian of the student.
Non-parent/guardian taxpayers will also need:
A signed Parental Consent Form that includes each student
 This shows that you have obtained permission from the legal guardian to utilize the student Household's federal Adjusted Gross Income as well as student and Household members' identifying information.
Non-Oklahoma taxpayers will also need:
Form 1040 Federal Tax Return for the tax year 2022
 Applicants who did not file Oklahoma State or Federal taxes in tax year 2022 are required to submit a completed copy of the Form 591-C.
